During Faith & Family Nights, our children are grouped in two age-based groups:

Children age 3— 1st grade, and
Children 2nd grade— 6th grade

The older group will start with educational programming (6:30 – 7pm) while the younger group will be in Children's Choir with Ms. Lisa. Then the younger kids switch to the educational programming (7-7:45pm) while the older kids go to Choir.

The programming for the evening will be very exciting with fun lessons, games, and crafts!

During Children's Choir, students will learn to sing contemporary, traditional, and global music. They will learn about various aspects of worship and liturgy, and experience prayer, and fellowship. The Children's Choirs will perform during church services once a month.
